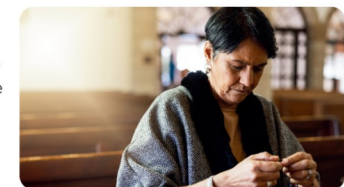

A PASTORAL LETTER FROM THE ROMAN CATHOLIC BISHOPS
 OF WISCONSIN ON END OF LIFE DECISIONS

We have published the 4th edition of our pastoral letter, *Now and at the Hour of Our Death*, to share the Church's moral guidance and helpful resources to help prepare for the end of life and relieve some of the pain, sadness, and anxiety that dying entails.
