A PASTORAL LETTER FROM THE ROMAN CATHOLIC BISHOPS OF WISCONSIN ON END OF LIFE DECISIONS

We have published the 4th edition of our pastoral letter, Now and at the Hour of Our Death, to share the Church's moral guidance and helpful resources to help prepare for the end of life and relieve some of the pain, sadness, and anxiety that dying entails. The letter includes Church teaching on a wide variety of issues at the end of life, including:

To assist in end of life planning, we also offer free legal forms, including the Catholic Authorization for Final Disposition and Addenda to the Power of Attorney for Health Care.
